



**POSTER**  
(revised 8-8-2005)

**Purpose**

To evaluate the contestant's ability to develop and prepare a SkillsUSA Virginia promotional poster.

First, refer to General Regulations.

**Eligibility**

Open to active SkillsUSA Virginia members

**Observer Rule**

Observers will not be present during the actual judging. Posters may be viewed on the day of the Skill Competitions contests.

**Pickup of Entries**

SkillsUSA Virginia will not be responsible for posters that have not been removed from the exhibit area by 12 noon on the day of the Skill Competitions contests. Failure to remove posters by this deadline could result in their damage or destruction by the cleaning crew.

**Equipment and Materials**

**1. Supplied by SkillsUSA Virginia:**

- a. One Judge
- b. One runner
- c. Five copies of rating sheets
- d. Five copies of regulations
- e. One copy of form to report results
- f. One set of contestant identification letters
- g. Four 6' tables
- h. Five pencils

**2. Supplied by the technical committee:**

- a. One chairman
- b. One judge
- c. One tape measure

**3. Supplied by the host:**

- a. One room (can be same room as Promotional Bulletin Board Display, Display, and Occupational Display)
- b. One judge
- c. Sufficient rope to secure static contest area

**4. Supplied by the Contestant**

- a. **One page personal resume' to be handed in at the beginning of the contest.**

## **Scope of the Contest**

1. The theme for the poster will be the current National SkillsUSA theme and must be stated on the poster.
2. The poster shall be designed and constructed by one SkillsUSA Virginia member only.
3. Entries shall be constructed on white 22" x 28" poster board.
4. Entries may not have any attachments to the poster (molding, framing, mock-ups, module, photographs, collages, stick-ons, etc.).
5. Only students will be allowed to set up the posters.
6. A letter of documentation stating that the poster was the original and creative work of the individual chapter member must be submitted. The letter is to be signed by the student, instructor, and principal and placed in a plain envelope on the back of the poster.
7. Failure to comply with any requirement listed above will result in a ten-point penalty for each rule violation.
